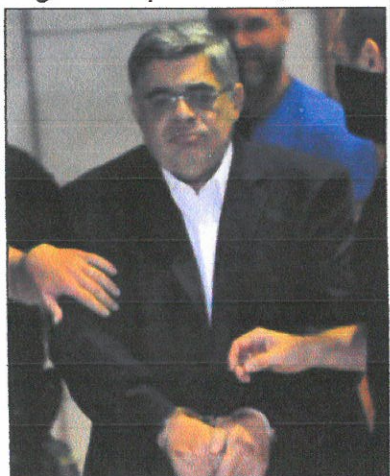


Golden Dawn Trial: The summary.

On the night of September 17, 2013, 45-year-old Georgios Roupakias, a member of the Golden Dawn (criminal) organization, stabbed to death Pavlos Fyssas, a 34-year-old hip hop musician in Keratsini for his anti-fascist activities, known by the stage name "Killah P".

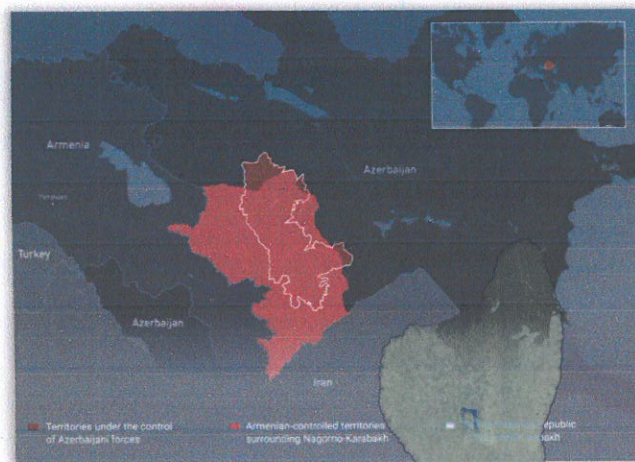
On October 7, 2020, and while a large crowd of 20,000 to 30,000 protesters had gathered outside the Court of Appeals, the unanimous decisions of the three members were announced, which included, among others, the recognition of Golden Dawn as a criminal organization-gang under Article 187 of the Penal Code. Specifically, George Roupakias was found guilty of all charges against him for the murder of Pavlos Fyssas.

With the approval of the Prime Minister, the Minister of Public Order, Nikos Dendias, ordered a police investigation into Golden Dawn offices the day after the assassination, while on 19 September he drafted with the help of two lawyers and sent to the prosecutor of the Supreme Court, Efterpi Koutzamanis, a letter referring to 32 incidents in which Golden Dawn members were involved requesting that the Golden Dawn act as a criminal organization be investigated. September 22, the prosecutor of the Supreme Court ordered an urgent preliminary investigation, which he assigned to the Deputy Prosecutor Charalambos Vourliotis, to determine whether there is a criminal organization.



The Nagorno-Karabakh Conflict

The clashes are part of the Nagorno-Karabakh conflict, a dispute over Nagorno-Karabakh with the ethnic Armenians in the majority,^{[86][87][88][89]} a disputed region in the South Caucasus between Azerbaijan and Armenia.^[72] Nagorno-Karabakh is a de jure part of Azerbaijan, but is de facto held by the self-proclaimed Republic of Artsakh, which is supported by Armenia.^[90] Ethnic violence began in the late 1980s, and exploded into a full war following the dissolution of the USSR in 1991. On 23 July 2020, Armenia announced the start of a joint air defence system exercise with Russia and an analysis of the July 2020 clashes.^[97] A week later, Azerbaijan conducted a series of military exercises that lasted from 29 July to 10 August,^[98] and further exercises in early September with the involvement of Turkey.^[99] Turkey's support for Azerbaijan has been seen as connected to its expansionist, neo-Ottoman foreign policy,^[100] linking its intervention to its policies in Syria, Iraq, and the Eastern Mediterranean.

Deadly Explosion in Iran.

At least five people have been killed in an explosion attributed to a gas leak that has razed homes and shops in a market in southwestern Iran, an official has said. There have been a number of explosions and fires in Iran recently, some of them in "sensitive" industrial and nuclear installations.

State television broadcast a video in which rescuers search for survivors in the rubble of a two-story house near the historic market in the old district of Ahvaz, the capital of Khuzestan province.

"The explosion completely destroyed a two-story house (...) and four neighboring buildings and six shops," said fire Chief Ebrahim Kanbari, according to the semi-official Mehr news agency.

Four men and a woman were killed and nine others were injured.

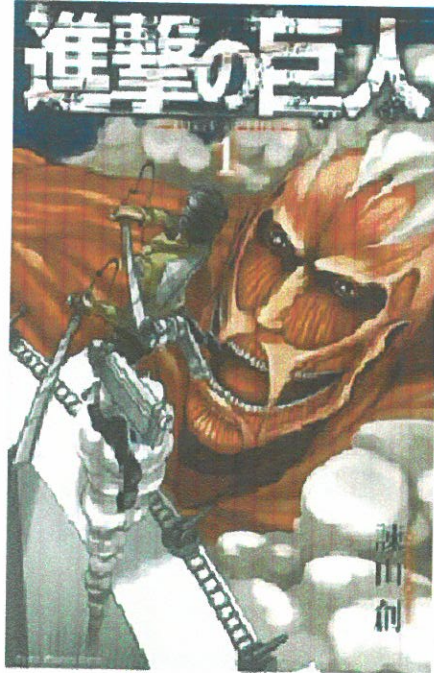

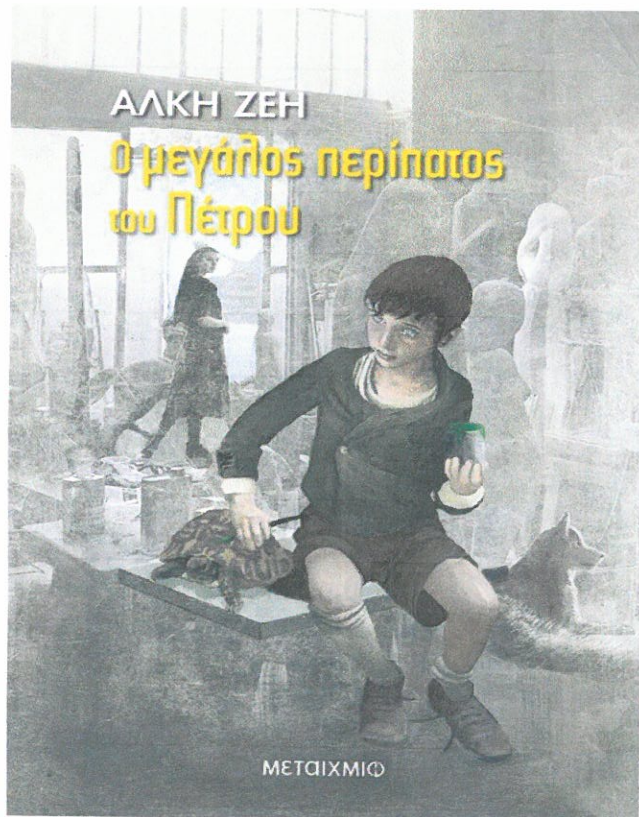

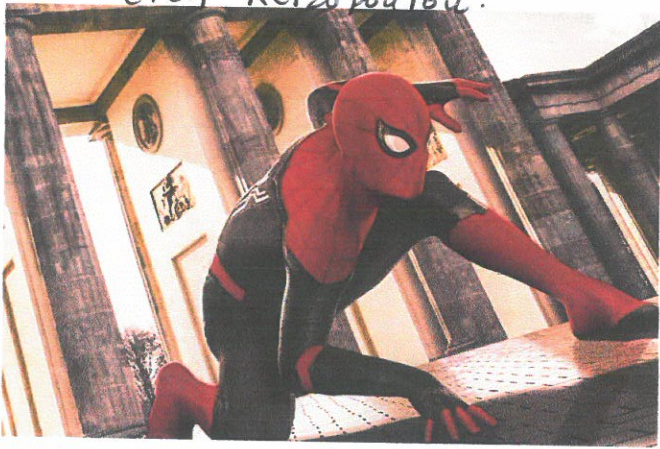
Blinding Lights

From the start of the film, strange things are happening—the small Mexican town of Ixtenco has been reduced to ruins by what residents call a cyclone with a face. Other towns elsewhere have been similarly threatened by the monster, Nick Fury has shown up and taken note. He communicates with Tony Stark's friend, Happy Hogan, to go backstage at the benefit and let Peter know that his Spider services will be required. But Peter has other plans: the school year is nearing its end, and he and a handful of classmates—including M.J. and Ned—are heading to Europe, under teachers' supervision, for a science trip, where Peter plans to make M.J like him back. The first stop is Venice, where the cyclone-like monster makes another appearance—a huge humanoid made of water that threatens the city's architectural treasures, its population, and Peter's friends. Peter's Spider-Man suit is up in his hotel room and he can't get to it in time—but another superhero, Quentin Beck, a greenish man with a green globe head and a trail of green smoke, makes an appearance and fights off the monster, appearing on local news, as Mysterio. Then Nick Fury arrives and persuades Peter into sacrificing the trip in order to save the world—and guilts Peter, too, with the delivery of a gift and a legacy: Tony Stark's distinctive sunglasses, which the dying hero had willed to Peter. But those glasses turn out to be something more: the command center of Tony's interactive system, called Edith—an acronym for "Even dead, I'm the hero." Nick gets Peter into a meeting with Mysterio, who explains the danger they face: the monster is one of the four so-called Elementals—of earth, air, fire, and water. The fire monster is about to lay waste to Prague, where Peter and Beck must go in order to stop it and thwart its plans to destroy the world.

Yummy-Yummy

nutella chocolate chip cookies**Butter:** Use room temperature butter.**Sugars:** We use a mix of brown and granulated sugar in these cookies. Brown sugar yields soft cookies and white sugar helps the cookies spread.**Eggs:** Use 1 whole egg, plus 1 extra egg yolk.**Salt & Vanilla Extract:** Both add flavor.**Nutella:** 1/4 cup of Nutella replaces 1/4 cup of butter in this cookie dough, and another 1/4 cup is swirled throughout.**Flour:** Sturdy all-purpose flour serves as the base of these cookies.**Baking Soda****Cornstarch****Chocolate Chips:** Use 1 and 1/4 cups of chocolate chips in this cookie recipe.**Sea Salt:** (optional)

Preheat the oven to 177°C. Line two large baking sheets with parchment paper or silicone baking mats. Set aside.

In a large bowl using a hand-held mixer or stand mixer fitted with a paddle attachment, beat the butter for 1 minute on medium speed until completely smooth and creamy. Add the brown sugar and granulated sugar and beat on medium high speed until fluffy and light in color. Beat in egg, egg yolk, and vanilla on high speed until combined. Scrape down the sides and bottom of the bowl as needed. Beat in (74g) of Nutella until combined.

Whisk the flour, cornstarch, baking soda and salt together in a large bowl. On low speed, slowly mix into the wet ingredients until combined. Add 180g of chocolate chips and mix on low for about 5-10 seconds until evenly dispersed. Turn the mixer off and add the remaining Nutella. Beat for 10 seconds so the Nutella streaks through the cookie dough and is not fully mixed. Dough will be a little crumbly, that is OK. Dough will be extremely crumbly if the remaining Nutella was mixed in too much. Scoop and roll balls of dough, about 1 Tablespoon of dough each, into balls. The warmth of your hands will help them come together. Arrange 3 inches apart on prepared baking sheets. Bake the cookies for 10 minutes or until slightly golden brown around the edges. Be sure to rotate the pan once during bake time. The baked cookies will look extremely soft in the centers when you remove them from the oven. Cool for 5 minutes on the baking sheet. If the cookies are too puffy, try gently pressing down on them with the back of a spoon. They will slightly deflate as you let them cool. As the cookies cool, grab the remaining 1/4 cup of chocolate chips and gently press them on the slightly warm cookies.

Recipe
cake

- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 2 large eggs
- 1/2 cup milk
- 1/2 cup water
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 2 tablespoons butter, melted

Step 1:

In a large mixing bowl, whisk together the flour and the eggs. Gradually add in the milk and water, stirring to combine. Add the salt and butter; beat until smooth.

Step 2:

Heat a lightly oiled griddle or frying pan over medium high heat. Pour or scoop the batter onto the griddle, using approximately 1/4 cup for each crepe. Tilt the pan with a circular motion so that the batter coat the surface evenly.

Step 3:

Cook the crepe for about 2 minutes, until the bottom is light brown. Loosen with a spatula, turn and cook the other side. Serve hot!!
